5. Why does Biff come home in the spring? What is the symbolism of the new colts and Texas in the spring? How does this juxtapose with the city in the summer?
6. Why won't Happy go out West with Biff, and why won't Biff stay? Explain what it means to "get ahead of the next fella".
7. Why doesn't either son get married and settle down?
8. How does Willy act toward the boys when they are young? How do they act toward him?

9. What does Willy's reaction to Biff's theft of the football tell us about Willy? About Biff? About their relationship?

10. How does Willy feel about Charley and Bernard?

11. Willy says the boys look like Adonises; what other clues show that Willy believes in appearances? What does he think of his own, specifically how when he tells Linda about how much he's sold?

12. "Five hundred gross in Providence" becomes "roughly two hundred gross the whole trip." How does Linda take Willy's stories? What does this reveal about her?

13. Why does Willy make a fuss about Linda's mending stockings? How is this important to the play?

14. Why does Charley visit? How does he feel about Willy? How and why do they insult each other?

15. Who is Ben? Why does Ben appear? In the flashback, what does Ben teach Biff? How does Charley react to what he teaches Willy/Biff?

16. Describe his father. What did he do for a living and how does this juxtapose with Willy? What is the symbolism of his father's flutes?

17. What happened to him? What is the symbolic meaning of diamonds and timber? (Diamonds will change—sort of—throughout the story.) How does this juxtapose with Willy's sales?
18. What does Linda think is the trouble with Willy's life? Why is she angry at her sons?
19. Why does she put the rubber hose back after she had taken it? What does this tell about her?
20. Why is Willy interested when Biff mentions Bill Oliver? Why do they argue?
21. How does Biff react to Willy yelling at Linda? Why does he come to his mother's defense "all the time"?
22. Why is Willy unable to let Biff go to bed without saying more to him about Bill Oliver? What does Biff's reaction tell us about their relationship?
