- Do you have any particularly strong opinions regarding the article's topic? If yes, what are they? If no, please provide a brief explanation.
- What is one thing you liked about the article?
- What is one thing you disliked about the article?

Section 3: Generating Questions for Discussion

In this section, supply at least three to five discussion questions that could be used in a classroom setting. Try to think of questions that might provoke a response from other classmates, but avoid being offensive or abrasive. Always try to generate questions that will encourage deeper-level thinking and meaningful dialogue.
